



The John Moe Scholarship for Graduates of the Salem-Keizer Public Schools Community Transition Program

This scholarship honors a champion for all students, Mr. John Moe. Like many of us, John was determined to make the world a better place. His love for music and music education is surpassed only by his deep commitment to furthering opportunities and meaningful life experiences for students of all abilities. John advocated for the interests of the disabled for over three decades. This scholarship, similar to one he supports in Long Beach, California is financed by his energy and patience.

This scholarship will now institutionalize the champion. Each student eligible and/or awarded will know for a lifetime that they had an advocate who will cheer and believe in them.

Students who are enrolled in Salem Keizer School District
Community Transition Program (CTP) are encouraged to apply.

The following criteria will be used to nominate students:

1. Minimum Requirement:

- Student is in their final year of CTP and is exiting school age services
- Letter of Recommendation from the CTP teacher highlighting student triumphs and accomplishments
- Submit letters of recommendation to Brian Hilsabeck at Student Services by 5pm on Friday, April, 27th 2018
- Completed Application and written response to 3 questions on reverse.

2. Student has shown growth in the following areas:

- Attendance
- Independence
- Social Interactions
- Employability (Behaviors, Punctuality, etc.)
- Community Transition Program

3. Student Interview:

- Students will be interviewed by Krina Lee, Salem-Keizer Education Foundation President, Brian Hilsabeck, Special Education Coordinator and other designee
- Accommodations/Modifications will be provided for students with communication needs.

**Interviews will be held on or around Thursday, May 10, 2018 at an agreed upon place and time.
Scholarships will be announced at graduation on May 24th.**
