Program Cancellation and Refund Policy

The purpose of our refund policy is to allow SKEF to offer quality programs and proper class ratios while maintaining flexibility for you. If we combine classes and the rescheduling prevents you from participating, and/or cancel a program you will be given a full credit towards another class/program or a full refund. In order to keep our fees as low as possible, we will not be able to issue refunds for missed classes or activities, even if they occur as a result of inclement weather. If a participant needs to withdraw from an activity for any reason, SKEF must be notified in writing at least 7 days before the activity begins and a full credit or refund, less a non-refundable \$25 registration fee, will be issued within 2-4 weeks of the cancellation.
